* It is not mandatory to produce the Declaration of Value at this stage; applicants can produce it after having applied on the Universitaly portal. Nonetheless, this document is necessary in order to complete the enrolment process.

Next steps:

1) Applicants will receive an Admission Letter and will enroll on the FY Programme through the website universitaly.it submitting a pre-enrolment request form.

2) The University of Parma will issue a Validation Letter once applicants have paid 15% of tuition fees and sent a copy of the money transfer receipt to <u>foundationyear@unipr.it</u>.

3) Applicants holding their Admission Letter and Validation Letter are requested to apply for a type D Visa (study purpose) at the Italian Embassy/Consulate in their home country.

4) If candidates don't obtain a visa for study purposes (type D), the University of Parma will refund the tuition fees paid (see point 2), except bank charges and the amount due (€300) for the online Italian language course which is compulsory for absolute beginners.

5) Prospective students are requested to pay 65% of tuition fee by:

-"Early Birds": 8 September 2024;

-"Regular" and "Dante": 1 October 2024.

6) Students are requested to pay the remaining 20% of total tuition fees by:

-"Early Birds": 1 October 2024;

-"Regular" and "Dante": 22 October 2024.

Students will be admitted in chronological order upon payment.
